Minutes of Sparta Library Board of Trustees

September 14, 2022

Unfinished Business:

Dave Costa stated that he was introducing a resolution to provide comp time to all library staff who remain working during hours when the Township Manager closes other Township departments early.

After discussion, on motion by Doreen Skok, seconded by Mary Coe and unanimously carried, the resolution was adopted as presented.

New Business:

Dave Costa indicated that he would be conducting staff evaluations. After a discussion, the Board decided to evaluate Dave on a two year basis.

Dave stated that he had been approached by the Township Clerk's office to consider the Library as a polling location. After discussion, on motion by Mary Coe, seconded by Amy DelCoro and unanimously carried, permission was granted by the Board to hold elections at the Library contingent upon a decision to be made by the Board of Elections.

Discussions also ensued regarding replacing plants and shrubbery at different locations on the Library grounds.
